20-10-01 Property Committee Report

Inside the Meetinghouse is a mess. Property Committee will schedule a workday so that members who are willing and able can help.

We are gaining experience through hosting outdoor Meeting for Worship weekly. We recognize that indoor Worship can not happen until the construction projects are complete and the Meetinghouse has been put back together and deeply cleaned. The conditions of the pandemic continue to change. The Discernment committee is monitoring the situation and is prepared to announce indoor face-to-face Worship and the specific conditions for indoor Worship when the time is right. The information will be posted on the listserve and announced at Zoom Worship.

20-10-05 Plans for Thanksgiving

A friend asked whether, in spite of the pandemic, the Meeting will host some kind of Thanksgiving gathering for Green Street members and attenders as has been our practice.
